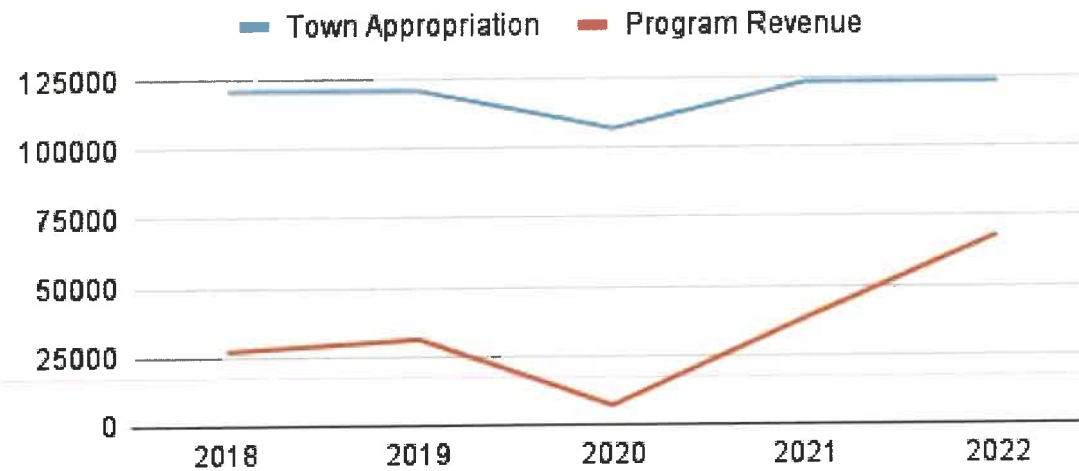

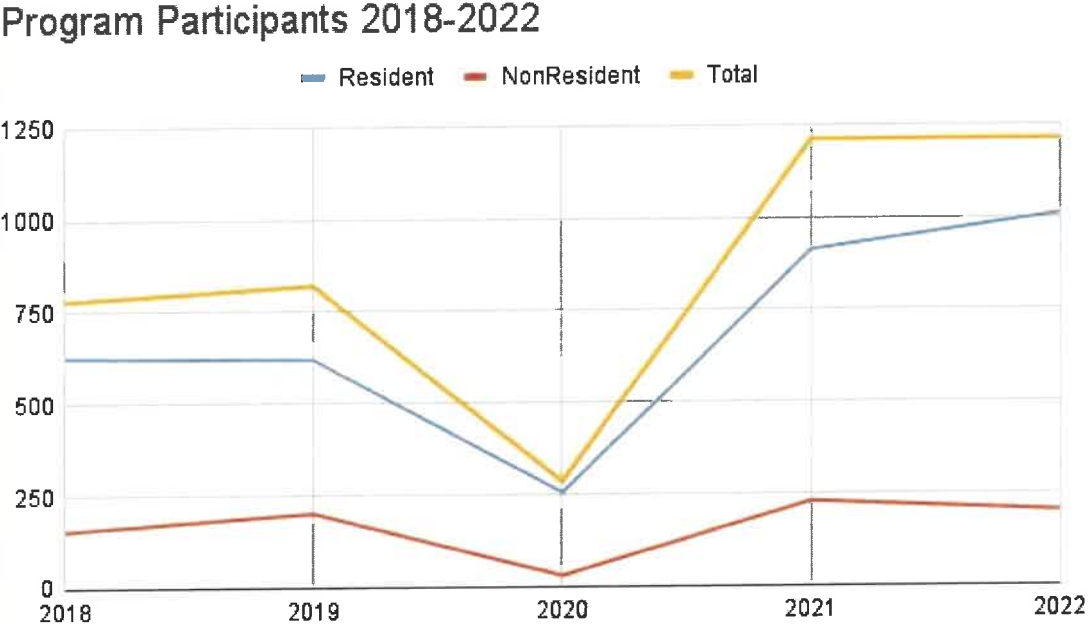

To create a space where all residents of Swanton and visitors alike will be able to engage in diverse recreational and cultural programs.

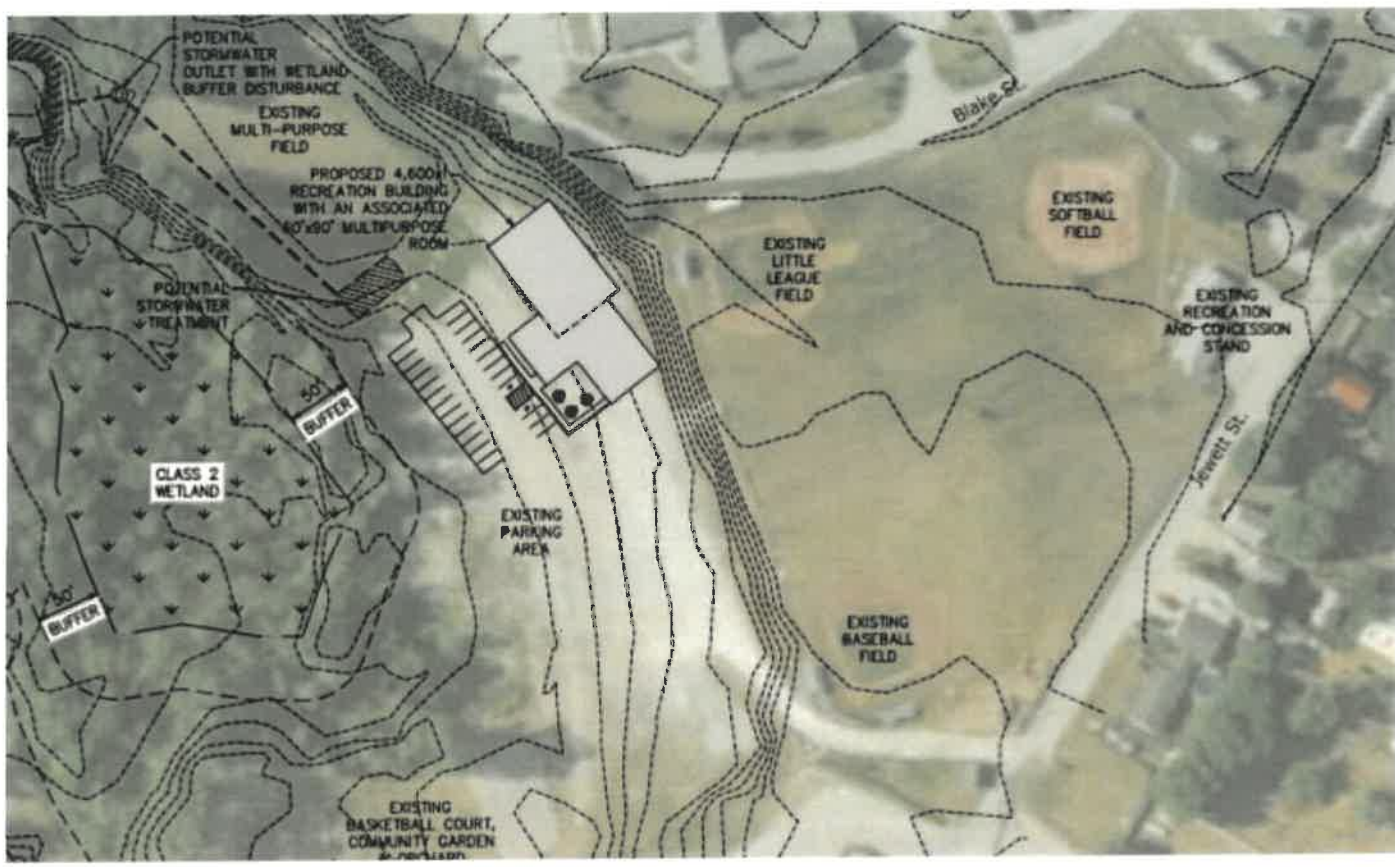
A space that will support all ages in developing community pride and spirit.

A space that can act as resource center to highlight healthy lifestyles and the general well-being of Swanton!

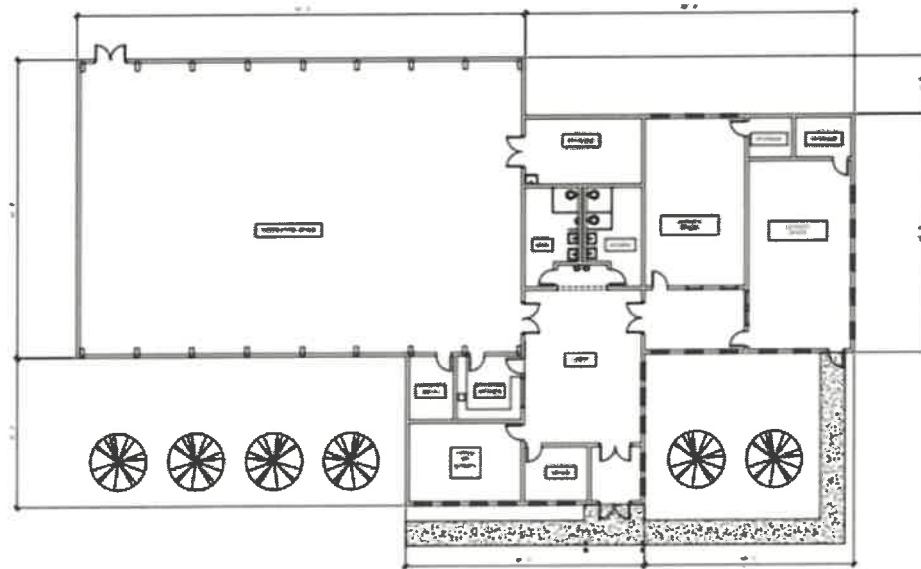

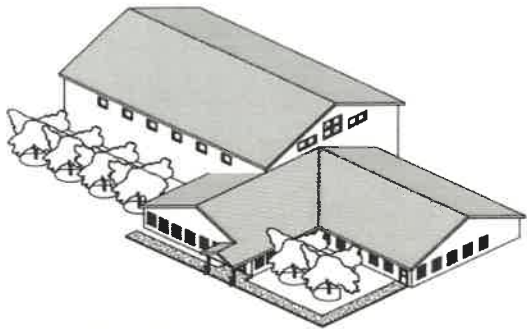

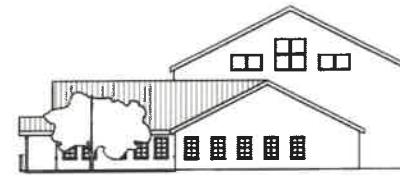
Initial Floorplan Concept:



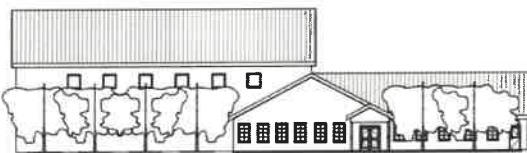
 **First Floor Plan**
Scale: 1/8" = 1'-0"



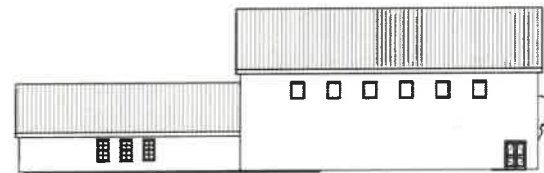
Isometric View - Southwest
