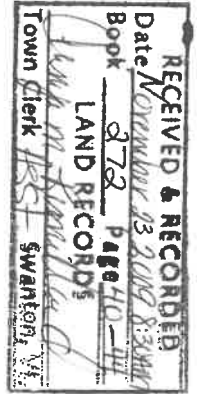


WHEREAS the Selectmen of the Town of Swanton have received an engineering and traffic investigation and have determined that the maximum speed permitted under Title 23, Chapter 13, Vermont Statutes Annotated, is greater than is reasonable and safe under conditions found to exist upon some of the highways with the Town of Swanton; NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted the Selectmen of the Town of Swanton by 23 V.S.A. Sections 1007 and 1008 and 24 V.S.A. Section 1971 et seq., the Selectmen of the Town of Swanton hereby amend the following Speed Limit Ordinance.



"SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE" (AMENDED)

Section 1: No person shall operate a motor vehicle, other than an authorized emergency vehicle, as those terms are defined by 23 V.S.A. Sections 4(21) and 4(1), respectively in excess of the following speeds (based on miles per hour) on the following highways:



This amended ordinance is hereby entered in the minutes of the Selectmen of the Town of Swanton and shall be posted in at least five conspicuous places within the Town of Swanton. Furthermore, a summary of it shall be published in the St. Albans Messenger within fourteen days of this date of adoption.

Unless a petition is filed pursuant to 24 V.S.A. Section 1973 is filed, this amended ordinance shall become effective sixty days after this date of adoption. If such petition is filed, this ordinance, shall become effective at the conclusion of the meeting called for that purpose.
