

SPEED ORDINANCE

Concerning the Regular of the Speed of Vehicles be it ordained that on this 21st day of February, A.D., 1990, by the Board of Trustees of Swanton Village:

SEC. 1: The following words and phrases, for purposes of this Ordinance, shall be defined as set forth in Title 23, Section 4 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated:

1. Person
2. Motor Vehicle
3. Tractor
4. Motorized highway building equipment
5. Road making appliances
6. Implements of husbandry

SEC. 2: No person shall operate a motor vehicle, tractor, motorized highway building equipment, road making appliance, implement of husbandry or any other vehicle, devise or appliance which is propelled or drawn by power, other than muscular power, at any time, in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour on any street, highway or other public way within the limits and boundary of Swanton Village.

SEC. 3: Any person who violates the provisions of Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be subject to being arrested by any temporarily or permanently appointed Town Constable or Police Officer, or by any State Police Officer, or person authorized to make such arrests by the State of Vermont upon its highways on said Officer's or person's Complaint, and said person so arrested shall be given the appropriate citation, summons or ticket, as prescribed by the Statutes or regulations of the State of Vermont, and shall be brought before the Vermont District Court or other judicial body as may be specified by the appropriate action and fine as prescribed by the Statutes and regulations of the State of Vermont.

SEC. 4: The Village Superintendent is hereby authorized and ordered to erect speed limit signs in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, at or as near as possible to the exact points at which the speed limit starts, and "Reduced Speed Ahead" signs at least 300 feet in advance of the beginning of the speed zone on each approach, including procurement of any permit needed for installations on other than Village rights-of-way.

SEC. 5: This Ordinance is made pursuant to and in conformity with the Charter of Swanton Village, as amended and in accordance with Title 23, Section 1007 and Title 24, Section 1971, Statutes of the State of Vermont; and all prior speed ordinances regarding streets, highways and public thoroughfares within the limits of Swanton Village, are hereby revoked.
