Community Recognition Day Policy

Purpose

To recognize Village of Swanton residents and employees whose long-standing service, civic dedication, or personal milestones reflect the values of commitment, integrity, and pride in our community.

Eligibility

Honorees must have a demonstrable connection to the Village of Swanton and meet one or more of the following criteria:

- 1. Village Service Recognition
 - o Individuals who have provided 25 years or more of dedicated service to the Village of Swanton in an official capacity, including:
 - Board of Trustees
 - Village President (Chair)
 - Fire Department
 - Police Department
 - Public Works Department
 - Electric Department
 - Water Department
 - Wastewater Department
 - Administration Department
- 2. Community Service Recognition
 - Village residents who have demonstrated exceptional volunteerism or leadership through long-term participation (10 years or more) in Village-based civic programs or committees, such as:
 - Swanton Enhancement Project (SEP)
 - Beautification Committee
 - Community events or initiatives that directly serve the Village of Swanton.
- 3. Veteran Recognition
 - Village residents who are U.S. military veterans and have reached the age of 95 years, or
 - Veterans aged 85 and older whose lifetime of service and community involvement reflects great distinction.

Type of Recognition

- The Village Board of Trustees may, by majority vote, issue a Proclamation designating a specific calendar date as "[Honoree's Name] Day" in the Village of Swanton.
- The day may be observed annually at the discretion of the Board.
- Proclamations are ceremonial in nature and do not convey legal holidays or closures.

Nomination & Approval Process

- 1. Nominations may be submitted by any Village resident, employee, or trustee.
- 2. Nominations must include a brief biographical summary, service record, and connection to the Village.
- 3. The Board of Trustees will review nominations at a regular meeting and approve recognitions by motion and majority vote.
- 4. Approved proclamations will be read into the public record, signed by all Trustees, and presented to the honoree or their family.

Presentation

- Proclamations will typically be presented at a Village meeting or public event, with copies provided to the honoree and local media.
- The Village Board may coordinate with the Town of Swanton or the Governor's Office for joint recognition when appropriate.
